"This is the highest honor a Construction Management practitioner can achieve and it is because of his tireless efforts on behalf of CMAA that Gary has been so honored", says Christine Keville, President of CMAA.

The CMAA College of Fellows is a cooperative of construction industry leaders dedicated to identifying and developing future leaders in the construction industry. The College also addresses strategic issues facing the practice of construction management and the industry as a whole.

Berman will be inducted at CMAA's National CM Conference in San Antonio, Texas on September 14, 2005. In attendance will be more than 600 construction management buyers and practitioners from around the world.

In 1996 Berman co-founded Greyhawk North America, LLC, a national construction management and consulting firm. He is a registered professional engineer and is one of the nation's leading experts in the fabrication and erection of structural steel.
